## Feature

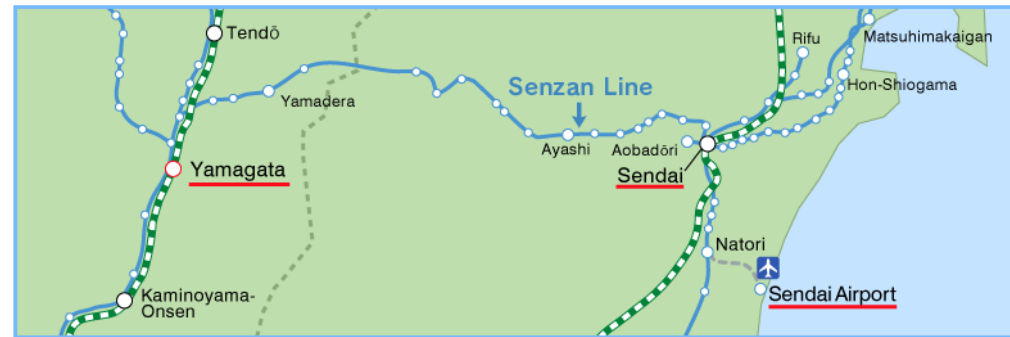
- One of the largest research conferences in Japan on soil and groundwater contamination issues
